1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*
- 1.2 The prescriptions and special regulations of Yachting Australia (YA) Part 2 will apply

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Int. Contender class.
- 2.2 Late entries may not be accepted after 1000 hours on Saturday 23rd of March 2019.

3 FEES

- 3.1 The Entry Fee is AUD \$80.00 per boat and \$100 Association Membership Fee (not applicable to those who have paid the fee to another division of the International Contender Class Association)
Total Fee \$180.00

- 4.2 On the last day of scheduled racing no warning signal will be made after 16:00.

5 MEASUREMENT

- 5.1 Each boat shall be required to produce a valid measurement certificate.
- 5.2 No measurement of new yachts or equipment will be conducted at these championships.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 6.1 Sailing Instructions will be available prior to Thursday 14th of March 2019 on the GLYC Website (www.sailglyc.com)

7 COURSES

- 7.1 The courses sailed will be triangular/windward/leeward.

8 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 8.1 For the contender class RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

9 SCORING

- 9.1 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
 - a) When fewer than three races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
 - b) When five or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

10 RADIO COMMUNICATION

10.1 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

11 PRIZES

11.1 Prizes will be given as follows:

- 1st, 2nd, 3rd Overall
- Victorian Contender Championship Trophy

12 INSURANCE

12.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5000000.00 per incident or the equivalent

13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

13.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
