## Our Commitment

GLYC is committed to encouraging members to participate in social activities within the club. Our Members Draw is one activity designed to encourage participation in Friday Night Members Night.

## Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that our Members Draw is conducted in a manner that is legal and transparent.

## Policy statement

The Members Draw will be conducted by Bar Staff or a responsible Committee member each Friday night – “club night”.

## Guidelines for Implementation

- The draw is funded from Club funds with the Club contributing \$20 each time a Friday social is run and the pool keeps rising until it is won. The minimum pool is \$50 with the Club making up the difference if the accumulated pool has not reached \$50 when won.
- The prize money continues to build until the cap of \$500 is reached. Once the \$500 cap is reached the extra prize pool money will be carried over for the next Draw.
- Only Senior Members, Adult Family Members and Social Members who are financial as at the date of each draw, as well as Life Members, are eligible to participate in the *Members Draw*. NB. A family membership entitles two adult members to be included in *the Draw*.
- The member (whose name is drawn) must be present in the clubhouse at the time of the draw.
- A record of the names drawn is kept in a notebook that is kept in the drawer under the left side of the Loft Bar. If the Draw takes place downstairs, please make sure the book is returned upstairs.
- When the money is won, the pool amount, or the maximum \$500, is paid directly to the bank account of the winning member.
